- 1. Ensure that the probe with the blue ejection button and blue probe well are installed.
- 2. Remove the probe from the probe well
- 3. Observe the Oral Mode indicator on the display (flashing head icon).

If this icon is not flashing, press the Mode Å Selection button until the head icon appears.

- 4. Load a Welch Allyn probe cover.
- 5. Place the probe tip deep into the patient's sublinual pocket as shown.
- 6. Do not hand the probe to the patient to place in his or her own mouth.
- Always hold the probe in place, maintaining tissue contact until temperature is complete.





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Tips for Taking Oral Temperatures with SureTemp®

- Always allow patient to ask questions prior to placing probe in mouth. Encourage them not to speak while thermometer is taking a temperature.
- 2 Please inform your patient that biting the probe tip while taking the temperature may result in damage to the probe.
- 3. Use only Welch Allyn disposable probe covers. Use of any other probe cover may result in inaccurate temperature readings.
- 4. If you question a reading, recheck the temperature using the monitor mode on your thermometer. Take an oral temperature as described.
 - > Continue to hold the probe in place after the temperature displays
 - > Press the Mode Selection 📥 until the Monitor Mode 🔊 indicator appears on the screen
 - > Continue taking the temperature for approximately three minutes
 - > Long-term continuous monitoring is not recommended in any mode.

The following may interfere with accurate readings for up to 20 minutes:

- > Brushing teeth
- > Ingesting hot or cold liquids

> Eating

> Chewing gum or mints

> Smoking

> Activity such as climbing stairs or running.
